## 2007 BOUZERON • A. ET P. DE VILLAINÉ

That's right, Bouzeron, not Aligoté. Well, yes, the grape *is* Aligoté, but why be redundant. Don't all wine lovers know that a wine labeled BOUZERON must contain 100% Aligoté from the village of Bouzeron, the ideal *terroir* for Aligoté? If not, that's okay, we are here to educate. The de Villaines have been instrumental over the past several decades in bringing notoriety to the Bouzeron appellation, having been convinced that it produces the world's greatest Aligoté. Le Montrachet doesn't have to say Chardonnay, and Bouzeron doesn't have to say Aligoté. It is just understood, right?

You can enjoy Aligoté with a variety of hors d'oeuvres and dishes, and I like to open with it for company, then follow it with a big, rich Meursault or Puligny, for example.

## VIN DE SAVOIE BRUT • MICHEL QUENARD

Everyone seems to love the crisp, flinty whites Quenard produces on the impossibly steep, stony mountain slopes behind his winery in the Savoie, but few know about his sparkling wine. He uses the Jacquère grape and vinifies it *méthode champenoise*. Think refreshing, low alcohol, even bracing. What we have here is a great alternative to Champagne or Prosecco, something to add a little variety to your sparkling wine routine, presuming you have such a delightful routine.

Check out the color on this rosé—classic pink, it isn't salmon like a Bandol or cherry like a Tavel, just a perfect bright pink that leads you to expect the irresistible aroma of alpine strawberries. The palate is dry, fresh, and floral, with just the right amount of fruitiness and a balancing touch of chalky minerality. This is an expertly crafted southern rosé and is guaranteed to get the night started right. And hey, look, it's a 2008. Remember our two delicious 2008 Beaujolais Nouveaux? It is fun to have a new vintage to get to know!

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# VALUE OF THE MONTH

## 2007 CÔTES-DU-RHÔNE ROUGE "CYPRESS CUVÉE" • LOUIS BARRUOL

This is our second vintage of this special cuvée, just off the boat. Value seekers and lovers of big bold reds, search no more! Our prospecting for another great Côtes-du-Rhône after the unfortunate sale of Château du Trignon ended in Gigondas, at the doorstep of the talented young Louis Barruol. Louis had at his disposition a quantity of really high-quality fruit in the Côtes-du-Rhône, and he also just so happened to have the flexibility and the desire to do a special blend with us. He and Kermit joined forces to create this wine and it was an easy partnership, as both love the art of the blend. The southern Rhône, with its myriad varieties, is the area of France where the blend is king. What you have at Barruol's place is a number of different cuvées from different *terroirs*, different grape varieties, and slightly different *élevages*, all impeccably raised separately. Then Kermit steps in and orchestrates a harmonious concoction of these various raw materials. You have the dark, wild Mourvèdre, the richly fruited Grenache, and the spicy grip of the Syrah all vying for attention. The blend is, of course, bottled unfiltered, leaving none of the good stuff behind. Loaded with character and sporting great structure and surprising freshness to the black, meaty depths of fruit, it will make good drinking for years. Kermit told me that the raw materials he had to work with were so good, the real challenge (and fun) was finding the ideal balance of finesse, texture, and soul. The wine tastes a lot like a Gigondas or Châteauneuf-du-Pape.

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# CORSICA

## 2007 PATRIMONIO BLANC • YVES LECCIA

When we speak of impeccability, we speak of both the process and the results, because the two go hand in hand. And when we speak of impeccability, Yves Leccia must be not far from our minds. Yves gives us wines with gorgeous purity and complexity, never a wrong note but always a surprise and always interesting. His Patrimonio *blanc*, named after the village in northern Corsica that the vines call home, is made from the indigenous Vermentino grape, also grown in southern France and in Italy along the Ligurian coast. Yves's take is as good as you'll find—you get the freshness, honeysuckle, and wildflowers that are typical with a dose of the Corsican sea air and wild herbs, more depth and flesh than most Vermentinos, all in a classy package. It deserves its price. Don't miss tasting it. Patrimonio is the Vermentino's greatest *terroir*.

## 2005 E PROVE ROUGE • DOMAINE MAESTRACCI

Michel Raoust of Domaine Maestracci does things a little differently. He is the only one of our three Corsican *vignerons* who ages his red in wood. He uses a combination of *foudre* and *demi-muid*, none of them new. He releases his wine almost a year later than just about all of our other French reds, finding that the intensity of his granite *terroir*, planted in Nielluccio and Sciacarello with a touch of Grenache and Syrah, demands patience to come around, for the tannins to soften and the aromas to express themselves. So we are thankful that we can take advantage of his strategy to always present this complex red when it is ready to drink. It is a perfect companion to hearty meat dishes or cheeses.

## 2006 PATRIMONIO ROUGE “MORTA MAIO” DOMAINE ANTOINE ARENA

Arena's hard-to-find wines are the perfect embodiment of the unspoiled wildness of the island of Corsica. If you are lucky enough to visit the island and be served a hunk of boar that spent its life feasting on the wild bounty of the mountain slopes, you'll want to drink an Arena red.

The grape is Nielluccio, genetically related to Tuscany's Sangiovese, but the Corsican *terroir*, the chalky soil, the Mediterranean sun and sea air, plus Arena's personal vision, produce a wine that does not resemble Chianti at all.

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# SAINT-AUBIN SAMPLER!

**O**F ALL OUR COOL IDEAS, this one ranks pretty high up there for me. Kermit and I are always blown away by the quality of Philippe Colin's Saint-Aubins. After tasting them (they are all *premier cru*) you can't help but notice that the caliber is right up there with the finest village wines from Puligny and Chassagne. I know that Kermit has been suggesting to Jean-François Coche that a Saint-Aubin would be a great addition to his collection of white Burgundy holdings.

Each of Colin's three *terroirs* gives a wine so different, we decided to do what may be a first in the wine world (but you never know)—a Saint-Aubin Sampler, an opportunity to taste these three gems side by side and experience a tasting tour of the little-lauded, magnificent *terroir* of Saint-Aubin. *Bonne dégustation.*

## 2006 SAINT-AUBIN "LES CHAMPLOTS"

This parcel is the highest in altitude of these three and is composed of white limestone rocks, giving a very mineral, tightly wound wine with great finesse.

## 2006 SAINT-AUBIN "LES COMBES"

A *combe* is a valley, this one between Saint-Aubin and Chassagne-Montrachet. "Les Combes" is a neighbor of Chassagne's *premier cru* "Chenevottes" and much like that *cru*, it boasts a profound, richly textured profile and striking complexity. We're talking delicious *and* interesting.

## 2006 SAINT-AUBIN "LE CHARMOIS"

This vineyard borders the great Chassagne "Les Chaumées" and has a similar soil of red earth and limestone. The result is a distinctive Burgundy with a stony complexity, a real *goût de terroir*.
